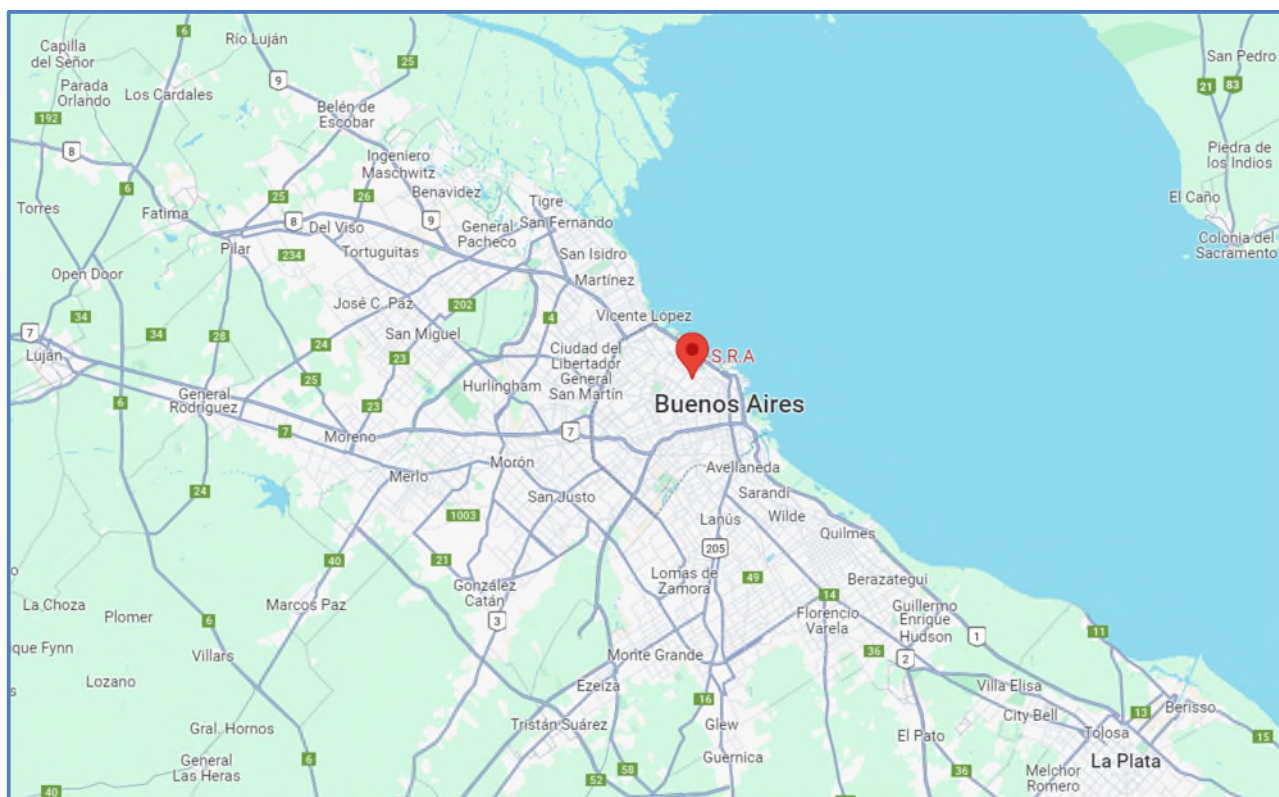

2. PLAYERS

Ladies and Pro Elite age limits: players may take part from the beginning of the year they reach the age of 16 (they must have 15 years at 1st January; FIHB GR ver.4.1 art.22.4 and FIHB SR ver.8.4 art.5a).

A player can participate at an event in only one team per category but in more teams in different categories with a maximum of two matches a day (FIHB GR ver.4.1 art.22.6 and FIHB SR ver.8.4 art.5a).

Each team can come with 8 players but a minimum of 6 players are mandatory.

3. HORSES

Each team can present with 8 Horses but minimum 7 horses are mandatory. Each horse can participate in one team only (FIHB SR ver.8.4 art.6a).

Senior: horses and pony D (height from 140cm to 148cm without shoes max 148,9cm; from 141cm to 149cm with shoes max 149,9cm).

v. Facilities

1. TEAMS

Accommodation: the expenses of the teams are included in the inscription fee.

Meals: lunch and dinner for the requested number of persons (6 to 10 persons) per team from the **dinner** on Monday March 24th to the **lunch** on Sunday March 30th, are included in the inscription fee.

Gala Dinner on Sunday 30th will be at an extra fee per person.

Additional meals: there are several opportunities to eat in La Rural, food trucks and restaurants; companions can choose the place where to eat.

2. HORSES

Transport: included for rented horses while at the expenses of the team for the own horses.

Rented horses: Rented horses will be draw from a pool of horses !

The horses will be identified by numbers in the stables and they will be allocated to players by a draw.

Teams that will use this method will also have the possibility to use 1 Joker spare horse in case there is an injury, or a player does not have empathy with him to be exchanged only in the 3 first days of competition, after that no changes will be allowed.

Price per rented Horse: 600 €

- Food included;
- Transport included;
- No grooms included extra fee can apply;
- Bridle and **Polo saddle** included;
- Saddle pads, bell boots, bandages, pickup strap, martingale and chest collar must be from team responsibility.

Payment: must be done in **cash presential**.

Availability: the horses will be available to the players right after the draw and they can be tried during the day of the 23th March.

Own Horses: Teams that want to present previously chosen horses for the competition are allowed to under the following conditions:

- There will be no chance to change the horses during the competition in any time, as knowing training and preparing in advance the horses will be consider one advantage;
- No Joker spare horses are allowed.

Extras: extras must be paid by the Teams, in particular (July 2024 prices):

- Hay bale: 4 €;
- Wood shavings bale: 3 €;
- Straw: 3 €.

From FIHB General Rules ver.4.1

Article 12bis: COMPETITIONS WITH BORROWED HORSES

International Competitions may be organized entirely (except for the NF hosting the competition if agreed) with horses borrowed by the host NF with the approval of FIHB. In such case, the following conditions apply.

12bis.1 The Organizing Committee will make available the necessary number of horses with at least one horse per player plus a spare pool. A veterinary must inspect all pooled horses before the draw, to determine their fitness.

12bis.2 The pooled horses must be suitable for Horse-Ball and be sufficiently big and strong to carry the rider. All pooled horses must be present and properly identified for example by a number printed on their bodies.

12bis.3 The Ground Jury is in charge of the drawing. The draw must take place immediately prior to the first practice, unless the Ground Jury rules otherwise. The host country will draw first. The order of the draw for the remaining countries will be decided by a draw done by the Supervisor. Each draw will then be for one horse only and this will continue until each player of that team has its horse.

12bis.4 Saddlery and equipment of good condition, approved by the owner of the horse, will be used.

12bis.5 The team may use any of the horses drawn during the competition. A rider must complete an event on the same horse except in case of injury to the horse.

12bis.6 The Organizing Committee should provide a spare pool of horses, but may only be drawn on if the Veterinary present rules that one of the team's horses is unsound or injured. In the absence of a Veterinary, the Ground Jury will rule on this point.

12bis.7 If a horse proves to be totally unsuitable, the team may appeal to the Ground Jury for a replacement from the spare pool.

12bis.8 Practice time: a maximum of two sessions of one and a half hour each will be allowed. This excludes saddling of the horses, but includes the warming up of the horses. A suitable practice pitch should be provided.

3. ADVERTISING AND PUBLICITY ON TEAMS AND HORSES EQUIPMENT

The Teams are authorised to show the logos of their personal sponsors on their own equipment but anyway they must inform FIHB first.

4. IMAGE RIGHTS

All the images of the FIHB competitions are property of FIHB under International laws. Copying, duplicating as a digital file, printing, publishing in form of media including web, manipulating, transmitting or reproducing without the prior written permission of FIHB is strictly forbidden and would constitute a breach of copyright.

VI. Miscellaneous

1. OPENING CEREMONY

All the National delegations (players, Team Leader and the Coach) must be present in the Opening Ceremony; the National delegation should wear a dress uniform. The ceremony will take place in the Competition Outdoor Arena on 24th March.

2. PRIZES - CLASSIFICATION

- FIHB medals for the top three teams in each category.
- FIHB cup for the Winner in each category.
- FIHB WHR trophy for all the teams;
- FIHB WHR trophy for Best Fair Play Team for each category;
- FIHB WHR trophy, one Kep Italia helmet and one pair of Parlanti knee pads for Best Horse/Player combination for each category.
- FIHB WHR trophy and one Kep Italia helmet for Top Scorer for each category.

The prize “Best Horse/Player combination” will be decided by the Team Leaders, Coaches and by the Ground Jury. The prize “Best Fair Play Team” will be decided by the pool of Referees and the Appeal Committee.

3. PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

All the players must be present in the Prize Giving Ceremony with the Team Leader and the Coach; all the players will be on foot unless the two teams of the last final match that will be on horseback with their grooms available to be able to get down to get on the podium.

All of them must respect the information of the Stewards in order to guarantee the best ceremony organisation.

4. INSURANCES

All owners, players and other members of the Teams (for example but not limited to, team leaders, coaches, grooms, veterinaries, doctors, drivers, etc.) are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

The Event will take place in South America, please be sure your insurance it's valid in South America - Argentina.

The International Horseball Federation (FIHB) and the Organising Committee renounce all responsibility for any injuries occurring to owners, players, horses and other members of the Teams caused by accidents and/or illness, and for all loss of property due to theft, damages, fire or mishaps, and to any damage to electronic/electrical appliances used by participants throughout the venue due to incidents with the power supply including but not limited to power surges. The participants will meet all repatriation costs following any accidents. Through their entry in the competition, the participants accept that the FIHB, the Organizing Committee and its agents cannot be held responsible for any accidents during the event and the duration of their stay at the same.

Each National Federation or ONHB must send proof of insurance for player and member of the team together with the definitive inscription.

Each player and member of the Team must sign the release form available as Annex 1.

5. ENTRY RIGHT TO SHOWGROUNDS

The entrance on the Stables Area is just allowed for Teams (players, Team Leader, Coach). Owners can enter by appointment of the Team Leader and with an authorisation of the OC.

VII. Veterinary Matters

1. VETERINARY INSPECTION BEFORE THE MATCHES

A veterinary inspection will be carried out each day on all participating teams for that day at least two hours before the matches.

During the veterinary inspection, all the players of a team must wear the same uniform (riding pants and game shirt) and wear clean and correct footwear (open shoes not allowed).

3. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ENTRY OF HORSES

REQUISITOS SANITARIOS ESPECÍFICOS PARA ÉQUIDOS

ARTÍCULO 18.- REQUISITOS GENERALES PARA ÉQUIDOS. Los équidos concurrentes deben cumplir con lo establecido en el apartado 22 del Anexo II de la Resolución N° 617 del 12 de agosto de 2005 de la ex SECRETARIA DE AGRICULTURA, GANADERÍA, PESCA Y ALIMENTOS, "Exposiciones Ganaderas".

ARTICULO 19.- ANEMIA INFECCIOSA EQUINA (AIE). A los fines del cumplimiento de los certificados diagnósticos que confirmen la ausencia de Anemia Infecciosa Equina (AIE) solicitados en el punto 22.2 del Anexo II de la Resolución N° 617 del 12 de agosto de 2005 de la ex SECRETARIA DE AGRICULTURA, GANADERIA, PESCA Y ALIMENTOS se establecen los siguientes requisitos específicos:

Inciso a) La toma de muestra de sangre debe ser realizada por el Veterinario Local del SENASA o Médico Veterinario Privado Acreditado ante el SENASA para enfermedades equinas.

Inciso b) La toma debe realizarse entre los CINCO (5) a los CUARENTA (40) días corridos previos al ingreso al predio ferial.

Inciso c) El diagnóstico debe realizarse en la Dirección del Laboratorio Animal de la DIRECCIÓN GENERAL DE LABORATORIOS Y CONTROL TÉCNICO (DGLyCT) del SENASA, o en los Laboratorios de la Red Nacional de Laboratorios de Ensayo y Diagnóstico del SENASA.

Inciso d) Se exceptúa de la presentación de diagnóstico negativo a AIE a los equinos que provengan de la zona libre de AIE.

Inciso e) En aquellos casos en que el animal se envíe a la zona libre de AIE, debe cumplir con lo normado por la Resolución N° 386 del 15 de junio 2017 del SERVICIO NACIONAL DE SANIDAD Y CALIDAD AGROALIMENTARIA, y que se detalla a continuación:

Apartado I) DT-E Y LIBRETA SANITARIA EQUINA O PASAPORTE EQUINO (se debe indicar el número de dicho documento en el DT-e).

Apartado II) TENER UN DIAGNÓSTICO NEGATIVO DE AIE que no haya superado el plazo de QUINCE (15) días corridos desde la fecha de extracción de la muestra.

Apartado III) En el caso de reingreso de animales a la zona libre de AIE y sólo si superan los QUINCE (15) días corridos de la emisión del DT-e con el cual ingresó a la EXPOSICION, debe presentarse un certificado nuevo de diagnóstico negativo a AIE.

ARTÍCULO 20.- INFLUENZA EQUINA. Se establecen los requisitos sanitarios relativos a la Influenza equina que deben cumplir los équidos concurrentes a la EXPOSICION, que a continuación se detallan:

Inciso a) Los équidos concurrentes deben ser vacunados por el Veterinario Local del SENASA o por el Médico Veterinario Privado Acreditado ante el SENASA, en DOS (2) oportunidades, la primera entre los VEINTE (20) y SESENTA (60) días corridos previos al ingreso a la exposición y la segunda no menos de DIEZ (10) días corridos antes del despacho a la misma.

ARTÍCULO 21.- RABIA PARESIANTE. Se establecen los requisitos sanitarios relativos a la rabia paresiante que deben cumplir los animales de la especie equina concurrentes a la EXPOSICION, que a continuación se detallan:

Inciso a) Los animales procedentes del área endémica de Rabia Paresiante (al Norte del Paralelo 31° Latitud Sur y al Este del Meridiano 66° Longitud Oeste; incorporando además establecimientos de Córdoba: Departamento Rio Cuarto; La Rioja: Departamentos de General Ocampo, General Belgrano, San Martín, Chamental, Ángel Vicente Peñaloza y Juan Facundo Quiroga; San Luis: Departamentos de Ayacucho, Chacabuco y Junín) deben estar inmunizados contra la rabia con fecha no anterior a los ONCE (11) meses anteriores al momento de ingresar al predio ferial.

Apartado I) Los animales que hayan sido vacunados con anterioridad a los ONCE (11) meses previos al momento de ingresar a la EXPOSICION, deben ser vacunados con UNA (1) dosis de refuerzo de la vacuna antirrábica.

Apartado II) Los animales que nunca fueron vacunados contra la rabia deben recibir DOS (2) dosis de vacuna, aplicadas con un intervalo entre ambas vacunaciones de entre VEINTE (20) y TREINTA (30) días corridos; la aplicación de la última vacuna debe realizarse al menos TREINTA (30) días corridos antes del egreso del establecimiento.

VISTO el Expediente N° EX-2023-141567123-APN-DGTYA#SENASA; la Ley de Policía Sanitaria Animal N° 3.959, 22.421 y 27.233; la Resolución N° 38 del 3 de febrero de 2012 del entonces MINISTERIO DE AGRICULTURA, GANADERÍA Y PESCA; las Resoluciones Nros. RESOL-2021-153-APN-PRES#SENASA del 30 de marzo de 2021 y RESOL-2023-1219-APN-PRES#SENASA del 28 de noviembre de 2023, ambas del SERVICIO NACIONAL DE SANIDAD Y CALIDAD AGROALIMENTARIA; y las Disposiciones Nros. DI-2023-363-APN-DNSA#SENASA del 26 de noviembre de 2023 y DI-2023-364-APN-

DNSA#SENASA del 30 de noviembre de 2023, ambas de la Dirección Nacional de Sanidad Animal y,

CONSIDERANDO:

Que por la Ley de Policía Sanitaria Animal N° 3.959 se prevé la defensa de los ganados en el territorio de la REPÚBLICA ARGENTINA contra la invasión de enfermedades contagiosas exóticas.

Que mediante la Ley N° 27.233 se declara de interés nacional la sanidad de los animales y los vegetales, así como la prevención, el control y la erradicación de las enfermedades y de las plagas que afecten la producción silvoagropecuaria nacional, la flora y la fauna, entre otros, siendo el SERVICIO NACIONAL DE SANIDAD Y CALIDAD AGROALIMENTARIA (SENASA) la autoridad de aplicación y el encargado de planificar, ejecutar y controlar el desarrollo de las acciones previstas en la referida ley.

Que asimismo, la citada norma establece que será responsabilidad primaria e ineludible de toda persona humana o jurídica vinculada a la producción, obtención o industrialización de productos, subproductos y derivados de origen silvoagropecuario y de la pesca, cuya actividad se encuentre sujeta al contralor de la autoridad de aplicación de la presente ley, el velar y responder por la sanidad, inocuidad, higiene y calidad de su producción, de conformidad a la normativa vigente y a la que en el futuro se establezca.

Que la Ley N° 22.421 declara de interés público la fauna silvestre que, temporal o permanentemente, habita el Territorio Nacional, así como su protección, conservación, propagación, repoblación y aprovechamiento racional.

Asimismo, instruye que el control sanitario de la fauna silvestre proveniente del exterior y la que fuera objeto de comercio de tránsito internacional o interprovincial, será ejercido por el entonces SERVICIO NACIONAL DE SANIDAD ANIMAL, de acuerdo con las leyes que reglan su competencia y funcionamiento.

Que mediante la Resolución N° RESOL-2021-153-APN-PRES#SENASA del 30 de marzo de 2021 del mentado Servicio Nacional se establece la obligatoriedad de notificar oficialmente y de manera inmediata al SENASA, la sospecha o confirmación de determinadas enfermedades incluidas en la lista que se detalla como Grupo I en el Anexo de la citada resolución, entre las que se encuentran la **Encefalomiелitis Equina del Este (EEE)**, del Oeste (EEO) y Venezolana (EEV).

Que la Resolución N° 38 del 3 de febrero de 2012 del entonces MINISTERIO DE AGRICULTURA, GANADERÍA Y PESCA y su modificatoria, se aprueba el Manual de Infracciones del SERVICIO NACIONAL DE SANIDAD Y CALIDAD AGROALIMENTARIA, donde se establece que todos los agentes del mencionado Servicio Nacional, así como aquellos agentes de entidades públicas o privadas que por delegación de funciones tengan a su cargo el cumplimiento de funciones emanadas de éste, se encuentran facultados, dentro del ámbito de su competencia, para intervenir en el cumplimiento de las medidas que sean de aplicación por parte de dicho Organismo.

Que en fecha 25 de noviembre de 2023 se han obtenido en el INSTITUTO NACIONAL DE TECNOLOGÍA AGROPECUARIA (INTA) - Castelar y en el Instituto Vanella de la UNIVERSIDAD NACIONAL DE CÓRDOBA, resultados positivos al virus del género de los Alfavirus, familia Togaviridae en las Provincias de CORRIENTES y SANTA FE.

Que estos virus afectan a varios vertebrados, entre ellos los equinos y las personas que son hospedadores terminales y son transmitidos por vectores, principalmente mosquitos, durante las épocas estivales.

Que en consecuencia, mediante la Resolución N° 1219 del 28 de noviembre del 2023 se declaró el Estado de Emergencia Sanitaria en todo el territorio de la REPÚBLICA ARGENTINA, estableciendo medidas sanitarias inmediatas, extraordinarias, excepcionales y de contención ante brotes de **Encefalomiелitis Equina (EE)**.

Que la mentada norma ratificó lo dispuesto en la Disposición N° 363 del 26 de noviembre del 2023 de la Dirección Nacional de Sanidad Animal, la cual prohíbe los movimientos de egreso de equinos desde las provincias afectadas, en las que se ha diagnosticado la enfermedad, al resto del país.

Que por su parte, la Disposición N° 364 del 30 de noviembre del 2023 modificó la exigibilidad de la vacunación, atento a la limitada e insuficiente disponibilidad de vacunas contra dicha enfermedad.

Que el SENASA ha gestionado y arbitrado los medios para regularizar la disponibilidad de vacunas, asegurando la distribución de las mismas según los criterios epidemiológicos.

Que en función de la evolución y los cambios de la situación epidemiológica de la enfermedad en el País, resulta necesario adaptar la normativa a las necesidades sanitarias y productivas.

Que al momento de la firma de la presente disposición la enfermedad se encuentra distribuida en las Provincias de BUENOS AIRES, CHACO, CORRIENTES, CÓRDOBA, ENTRE RÍOS, FORMOSA, LA PAMPA, SANTA FE, SANTIAGO del ESTERO, RÍO NEGRO, SAN LUIS y SALTA.

Que luego de la aprobación del estado de emergencia sanitaria por Encefalomiелitis Equina del Oeste, se articularon acciones en conjunto con otros organismos públicos y privados que permiten establecer medidas en base a la evolución de la enfermedad y a los resultados obtenidos luego de las medidas excepcionales aplicadas para la contingencia de los brotes.

Que a los fines del comercio internacional, para la exportación de mercancías equinas, el SENASA certificará su exportación sólo ante el cumplimiento de las exigencias del país importador.

Que la Dirección de Asuntos Jurídicos ha tomado la intervención que le compete. Que la suscripta es competente para dictar la presente medida de conformidad con lo dispuesto en la Decisión Administrativa N° 1881 del 10 de diciembre de 2018 y sus modificatorias y el artículo 4° de la Resolución N° 1219 del 28 de noviembre de 2023 del SERVICIO NACIONAL DE SANIDAD Y CALIDAD AGROALIMENTARIA.

Por ello,

LA DIRECTORA NACIONAL DE SANIDAD ANIMAL

DISPONE:

ARTÍCULO 1°.- Medidas sanitarias. Movimientos de Equinos Vacunados. Los equinos vacunados contra Encefalomiелitis Equina del Este y del Oeste podrán movilizarse por todo el territorio de la REPÚBLICA ARGENTINA, con la certificación sanitaria correspondiente en la que conste la vacunación con vacunas aprobadas por el SENASA, aplicada al menos QUINCE (15) días antes del movimiento.

ARTICULO 2°.- Medidas Sanitarias. Movimientos de Equinos no vacunados. Se establecen las siguientes condiciones para el movimiento de equinos no vacunados contra Encefalomiелitis equina del Este y del Oeste:

Inciso a) Los equinos no vacunados que se movilicen desde provincias en las que se ha diagnosticado encefalomiелitis equina, podrán hacerlo dentro de la misma provincia o hacia otras provincias que tengan la misma condición sanitaria, es decir, confirmación diagnóstica positiva de la enfermedad.

Inciso b) Los equinos no vacunados que se movilicen desde provincias en las que no se ha diagnosticado encefalomiелitis equina, podrán hacerlo dentro de la misma provincia o hacia otras provincias que tengan la misma condición sanitaria, es decir, en las que no se ha diagnosticado la enfermedad.

ARTÍCULO 3°.- Excepciones. Se establece la siguiente excepción a lo previsto en el Artículo 2°:

Inciso a) Equinos con destino faena directa. Se permite el movimiento de equinos en todo el Territorio Nacional con destino directo a frigoríficos.

ARTÍCULO 4°.- Concentraciones de equinos. A partir del 1° de febrero de 2024, los organizadores de eventos de concentración de equinos deberán exigir, antes del ingreso, que el animal cuente con una vacunación vigente para Encefalomiелitis Equina del Este y del Oeste aplicada al menos QUINCE (15) días antes del movimiento.

ARTÍCULO 5°.- Alcance. La presente medida es de aplicación en todo el territorio de la REPÚBLICA ARGENTINA.

ARTÍCULO 6°.- Infracciones. Sin perjuicio de las medidas preventivas adicionales que pudieran adoptarse de conformidad con lo dispuesto por la Resolución N° 38 del 3 de febrero de 2012 del entonces MINISTERIO DE AGRICULTURA, GANADERÍA Y PESCA y su modificatoria, el incumplimiento de lo establecido en la presente resolución es pasible de las sanciones previstas en el Capítulo V de la Ley N° 27.233 y su Decreto Reglamentario N° DECTO-2019-776-APN-PTE del 19 de noviembre de 2019.

ARTÍCULO 7°.- Abrogación. Se abrogan la Disposición N° 363 del 26 de noviembre del 2023 y la Disposición N° 364 del 30 de noviembre del 2023, ambas de la Dirección Nacional de Sanidad Animal.

ARTÍCULO 8°.- Incorporación. Se incorpora la presente resolución en el Libro Tercero, Parte Tercera, Título II, Capítulo II Sección 4° - Equinos y Título III, Capítulo IV del Índice Temático del Digesto Normativo del SERVICIO NACIONAL DE SANIDAD Y CALIDAD AGROALIMENTARIA, aprobado por la Resolución N° 401 del 14 de junio de 2010 y su complementaria N° 738 del 12 de octubre de 2011, ambas del citado Servicio Nacional.

ARTÍCULO 9°.- Vigencia. La presente disposición entra en vigencia a partir de su publicación en el Boletín Oficial.

ARTÍCULO 10°.- Comuníquese, publíquese, dese a la DIRECCIÓN NACIONAL DEL REGISTRO OFICIAL y archívese.
